The jury members then evaluate the result and select/short-list eligible entities and finalize the winners.





According to the website of IPPAI, this flagship annual event aims to discuss a new roadmap to achieve 'Power for All' in the country. IPPAI provides an engaging interface between top players in the energy sector, policymakers (central and state level), electricity boards, financial institutions, ministries, power developers, Indian and multinational companies, equipment suppliers, EPC contractors and consultants.

The Awards were conferred in various categories for excellence in the power sector, along with the category - Best Performing Distribution Company, where UGVCL won the Award.

IPPAI is an independent body that provides a neutral platform for the discussion and examination of issues critical to the development of the private power sector in India.
